	<p>mode of instruction or online mode of instruction, instructors <u>can</u> require students to keep cameras on in an online synchronous session and be recorded.</p> <p>Students with privacy or equity concerns should be advised that cameras <u>can</u> be required to be on, and if they have privacy or equity concerns, they should be advised to register for the course on campus (face-to-face mode of instruction).</p>	<p>system and to class session instructional material/s.</p> <p>If the student had the option to register for the class in a face-to-face mode of instruction or online mode of instruction, the instructor should:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Decide if they will be requiring students to have their cameras on and will be recorded and inform them as soon as possible. This allows students to decide if they prefer to register for the face-to-face course instead and not have their privacy rights violated. Make it clear in your syllabus if you are going to require your students to have their cameras on during synchronous sessions and be recorded.
