ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the Distance Education MSW program:

- x Completion of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university no later than Spring 2023
- x A cumulative undergraduate GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- x Completion of an approved prerequisite course in Elementary Statistics (a letter grade of "C" or better, a letter grade of "C" does not meet the requirement) no later than Spring 2023
