#### PRACTICUNEDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

The practicum experiences an integral part of the BASW curriculum, providing an opportunity for students to apply social work knowledge and practice skills in an agence, educational focused setting.

BASW students in their junior year must complete arh80r practicum at a community agency (8 hours per week for 10 weeks). BASW students in their senior year must complete 450 hours of practicum expterieungeout the academic year as well as attend a weekly seminar.
