An advanced degree (at least M.S.) in Mathematics, Statistics, or Math Education with evidence of strong math background; or, for instructors hired to teach only EDSS courses in the Single Subject Credential Program, substantial professional experience may be considered. Demonstrated potential for effective teaching. Must have the ability to communicate effectively with an ethnically and culturally diverse campus community.

Ph.D. in Mathematics, Statistics, or Math Education. Demonstrated expertise in field of course(s) to be taught, evidence of successful teaching in college-level math, statistics, or math ed courses.

Teach up to 15 units of courses such as GE Math, College-

institution awarding highest degree. Applicants offered employment will be required to submit a signed SC-1 Form and an official transcript.

Position open until filled (or recruitment canceled). Review of applications are ongoing for fall semester and application review will begin October 31 for spring semester. Applicant pool expires annually on June 30.
