Areas of Concern and Opportunities for Development were noted in the reports.

- x The College has developed a new 80/20 allocation agreement with other Colleges, however there still sees to be campus concern regarding financial partnerships. There is an opportunity to create a betternarketing and and transparent budgeting processes.
- x TheCollege andAcademic Affairs should examibedget allocation. It was unclear to the reviewers whether the resources spent on various programs and buildings was the responsibility of the college itself or the institution at large. The team also recommended that the College work to rebuild a three onth reserve.
- x CPIE programs have not participated in direct assessment activities ave they reported their direct or indirect assessment activities.

- There has been an increase in the number of degree and other programs that CPIE offers, but thedata provided seems to indicate a concomitant decrease in the number of enrollments in CPIE his is likely because CPIE has change denrollment data collection to focus more on specific programs, and not include participants in classes and summer camps PIE has the opportunity to analyze the viability of programs, as well as to continue to develop new opportunities for items and marketing programs meet our Beach 2030 goals of expanding outreach to help students complete degrees and participate in lifelong learn that should clearly reflects new enrollment trends.
- x With the Beach 2030 commitment to lifelong learningd developing more accessible programs to meet the needs of our community, CPIE has the opportunity to create more professional education and completion degrebavelopment of supplemental degrees will require an updated, standardized processes for impatibns, admissions, clarity in the distinction between stateside and supplemental programs, and faculty hiring.
