This garden was dedicated in 1981 to my late husband Earl Miller, who was a great lover of the outdoors, as am I. In fact, we met in the summer time during a trip that my father and I took to Sequoia National Park and later in 1918, I married Earl. Earl had received his degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Colorado and his love for the outdoors eventually guided his choice in careers. After a brief period of working for the City of Long Beach following World War I, Earl partnered with George Sully.

Their firm Sully-Miller became a major road building and construction company that paved some of the most prominent streets in Long Beach, including Ocean and An ahequity (April 1994) (Apr
