The Program will provide an annual update (due June 1) on progress made towards the actions agreed to in this MOU to the CHHS dean, the Vice Provost for Academic Programs, and the Coordinator of Program Review and Assessment. The review cycle will be from 2020-2026. A comprehensive accreditation self-study will be due June 2026 for the 2026/27 External review/UPRC report process.

- 2. Develop an assessment plan which expands beyond existing pre- and post-test measures to assess program objectives and submit relevant assessment reports to Coordinator for Program Review & Assessment and Vice Provost for Academic Programs according to institutional schedule.
- 3. Improve visibility and discoverability of the Program Learning Outcomes and the Mission for the Emergency Management Program from the College of Professional & International Education webpages.
- 4. Continue to develop faculty-student research, service-learning, and other mentoring opportunities further, especially given the online nature of the program.
- 5. Investigate purpose, benefits, and barriers for seeking accreditation from the Council for the Accreditation of Emergency Management and Homeland Security Education, and determine if accreditation is a goal for the program.
- 6. Work with the College to service, and teaching goals.
- 7. Work with the College to provide support for expanding service-learning and faculty-student research opportunities for graduate students, as resources permit.
