The 2008 Campus Master Plan proposed demolition of the existing Hillside Office/Commons in its place, the construction of a new dining hall in a building that would also include a coffee enience store, and new, expanded commons area, in the Hillside College residential complex us. Since Master Plan approval, other new facilities have been constructed elsewhere on now house some of the uses originally contemplated for the Hillside College dining hall a approved Campus Master Plan, eliminating the need for a dining hall as originally described d in the 2008 Campus Master Plan Update EIR. As a result of these projects, a new dining Hillside complex is no longer necessary. However, the campus still has the need for a new uilding to replace the Parkside complex housing administration building which was recently as well as to expand the commons area and associated space for support services for Hillside dents. As such, CSULB has prepared a Draft Supplemental EIR to evaluate the potential effects of constructing a new HRL building and a new commons building.
